

# At a Glance for Cannabis Analysis Application and Licensing

Version	Class 10
Regulatory function of the licence	This licence allows an Isle of Man laboratory to receive samples from others that may contain controlled cannabinoids, for the purposes of testing and reporting upon the chemistry of the samples.
When a licence isn't required	You do not require this licence if you are a test lab based elsewhere (i.e. not in the Isle of Man) testing the samples of Isle of Man licensees; You do not require this licence if you have a core licence (for example a cultivation, research, extraction or manufacturing licence) and intend to conduct your own in-house tests, or intend to have your samples sent to a test lab in the Isle of Man or elsewhere
Fees	In year 1, the fee is £13,125 In year 2 onwards, £8,400
Multi-licensing	Licensees can hold any number of licence classes. For example, a licensee may decide to set up a separate facility in the Isle of Man to test its own extractions, and offer that service to third parties under contract.
Accreditation	You must supply evidence of ISO17025 accreditation, or some form of equivalence.
Testing requirements	The GSC's testing for exports to non-commercial customers requires the following processes: For metals : ICP-MS For mycotoxins : HP-LC For chemical residue : GC-MS and LC-MS
Offering other testing services	The licence covers the possession of controlled cannabinoids. The licence does not preclude the offer of services in other fields. If your service collects samples for transport to the laboratory, then you will also require a transport and storage licence, so that you can operate the transport element. This licence costs £5,250 in the first year and £2,625 for all subsequent years.
