



Online Gambling Licence - Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for an OGRA licence, an operator must meet the following criteria:

- **Incorporation:** The operator must establish a company in the Isle of Man.
- **Local Governance:** The company must appoint at least two local directors, who must be natural persons (i.e., not corporate entities).
- **Resident Oversight:** The company must appoint at least one resident Designated Official. If a Designated Official cannot reside in the Isle of Man, an Operations Manager must be appointed instead.
- **Player Registration or Network Services:** The operator must either register players on servers located in the Isle of Man or operate under a network services licence, which requires the network services to be established in the Isle of Man (except in the case of a software supply-only licence – see below).
- **Player Fund Protection:** Any player fund protection accounts must be held in a bank located in the Isle of Man, unless otherwise agreed.
